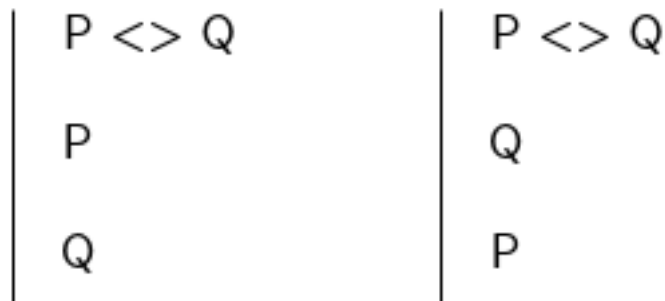


Figure 1: biconditional-elim.png
